Never use the same seat belt across two or more passengers.

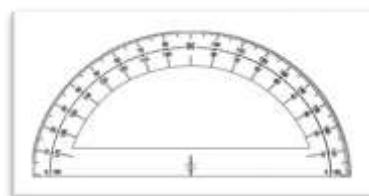

Parentpay

When purchasing a book please refer to the price list included in the latest newsletter. Select the '**Revision** Guides and **Workbook**' option.

In the notes field please enter the subject and whether it is a revision guide or workbook, and if the tier is Foundation or Higher. This will ensure the correct book is allocated to the student.

The price will always default to £10.50, please amend this to the correct amount from the latest price list within the Newsletter to ensure you are always paying the correct amount.

If you wish to buy more than one book a new transaction is required each time.
