Dear Parent /Carer,

Our Year 8 Outdoor Pursuits (Water Sports) Residential will take place over the weekend of 16th – 18th May 2025. Students will leave school at 2.30 pm on Friday 16th May 2025 and return at approximately 4.30 pm on Sunday 18th May 2025.

This residential will be held at the Arthog Outdoor Education Centre, situated on the Western Coast of Wales, in Snowdonia National Park overlooking the Mawddach Estuary. The centre has dormitory accommodation. Members of staff will be on duty throughout the night. A wide variety of meals are served and special dietary requirements will, of course, be catered for. Students will be taking part in a variety of water sports activities. The staff to student ratio will be 1:10 and whilst participating in activities, instructors will accompany groups at all times. The water-based activities, will require a full buoyancy aid to be worn.

The total cost will be between £210 - £230 depending on final numbers. The cost covers the return transport to the centre, accommodation, fully qualified instructional staff, use of specialist equipment and food.

Behaviour prior to the trip will need to be exemplary to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all students, and to allow the trip to run safely and successfully, all students must be prepared to abide by the school's behaviour code. If a student were to behave in a way that would put at risk the enjoyment and/or safety of other students, staff will contact parents/carers to arrange early collection of their child.

Wearing a seat belt not only helps protect your safety, but it also helps protect the safety of others.






