## Partial reopening of school for Year 10 students - Tutor Group 10S

I hope you and your family are well.

Further to the letter I sent to you, dated 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2020, I am pleased to confirm your child will be invited to attend school on the following days, from the week beginning Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June 2020:

Thursday 18th June

Thursday 25th June

Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> July

Thursday 9th July

Over the course of the 4 dates specified above, your child will be able to have face to face time with each of their class teachers for at least 2 hours. Miss Weston will be writing to you and your child shortly to outline the structure and aims of the time your child will spend with their class teachers.

As I am sure you are aware, there will need to be some changes to the daily routine and Mr Jervis will also be writing to you shortly with the details of these differences. Please would you ensure your child understands how their routine when in school will differ from how things were when they started Year 10.

To aid our planning, it would be very helpful if you could indicate whether your child will be attending on the dates specified. We understand some parents may not feel it is safe to send their child in to school and will respect the wishes of these parents. However, I can assure you I would not sanction the partial re-opening of the school, if the risks to any person in the school community were significant. Please would you ensure you have communicated your intentions to the school by Monday, 8<sup>th</sup> June at the latest via the email address <a href="mailto:year10@marywebbschool.com">year10@marywebbschool.com</a>. If you have already contacted us and have not changed your mind, there's no need to contact us again. If you contacted us to say you were undecided, please would you let us know if you have decided not to send your child in to school.

We also need to know how your child will be getting to school, on the dates specified. School transport will still be provided to those who need it. However, we appreciate some parents will want to make different arrangements. Please ensure you have contacted the school to inform us how your child will be travelling either by bus/car/bicycle or walking via <a href="mailto:year10@marywebbschool.com">year10@marywebbschool.com</a>.

When sending in your answers to the information requested above, via <a href="mailto:year10@marywebbschool.com">year10@marywebbschool.com</a> please include your child's name and form within the email.

All our plans for a partial re-opening are based on staff and students adhering to the new routines. At the top of this list are the following conditions:

- Staff and students can only attend school if they are free from all of the symptoms of coronavirus (COVID-19). These symptoms are specified as:
  - Persistent cough
  - Temperature
  - Loss of sense of smell and/or taste
- If staff or students have been in contact with a person diagnosed with coronavirus (COVID-19), they must self-isolate for 14 days, as per the guidance from the government.
