MEDICATION FOR STUDENTS



Please remember if you are sending medication into school for a student, it must be accompanied by an 'Administration of Medicine' consent form. This form is available to download from our website under 'Letters and Downloadable Forms', or can be collected from the School Office.

All medication must be in the original container and have the student's name on the prescription label. Medication must be handed into Reception where it will be stored safely.

Students are not permitted to carry medication.

The only exceptions are inhalers and epipens, for which we hold consent forms.

Please note without your permission we cannot administer your child's medication.

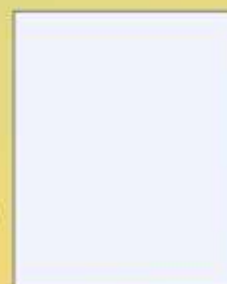
Please book spaces directly with the organisations running the holiday clubs.

What you need to do:

1. Use the electronic **What's On Guide** and searchable **Timetable** to find which holiday club is suitable for your child/ren. Electronic copies of the Guide will be sent to you by your child/ren's school and are also available at: www.shropshire.gov.uk/HAF.
2. Book onto activity by contacting the organisation running the holiday club direct, using the contact details in the Guide.
3. When making a booking, **please quote your unique HAF Code (see box below)**.
4. If your child/ren has SEND (Special Educational Needs & Disabilities) or receives any extra help at school, before booking onto activity, please contact the holiday club to discuss your child/s needs.
5. Any queries you have about your booking or the activities on offer, please contact the organisation running the holiday club directly.
6. If you meet the wider eligibility criteria, please contact, HAF.programme@shropshire.gov.uk for information about referrals onto the programme.

The unique code entitles your child/ren to attend 16 sessions of free holiday activity in Shropshire during the Summer holidays 2025. Please don't use this code to book onto more than 16 sessions of activity or to book onto multiple programmes of activity with different providers, happening at the same time.

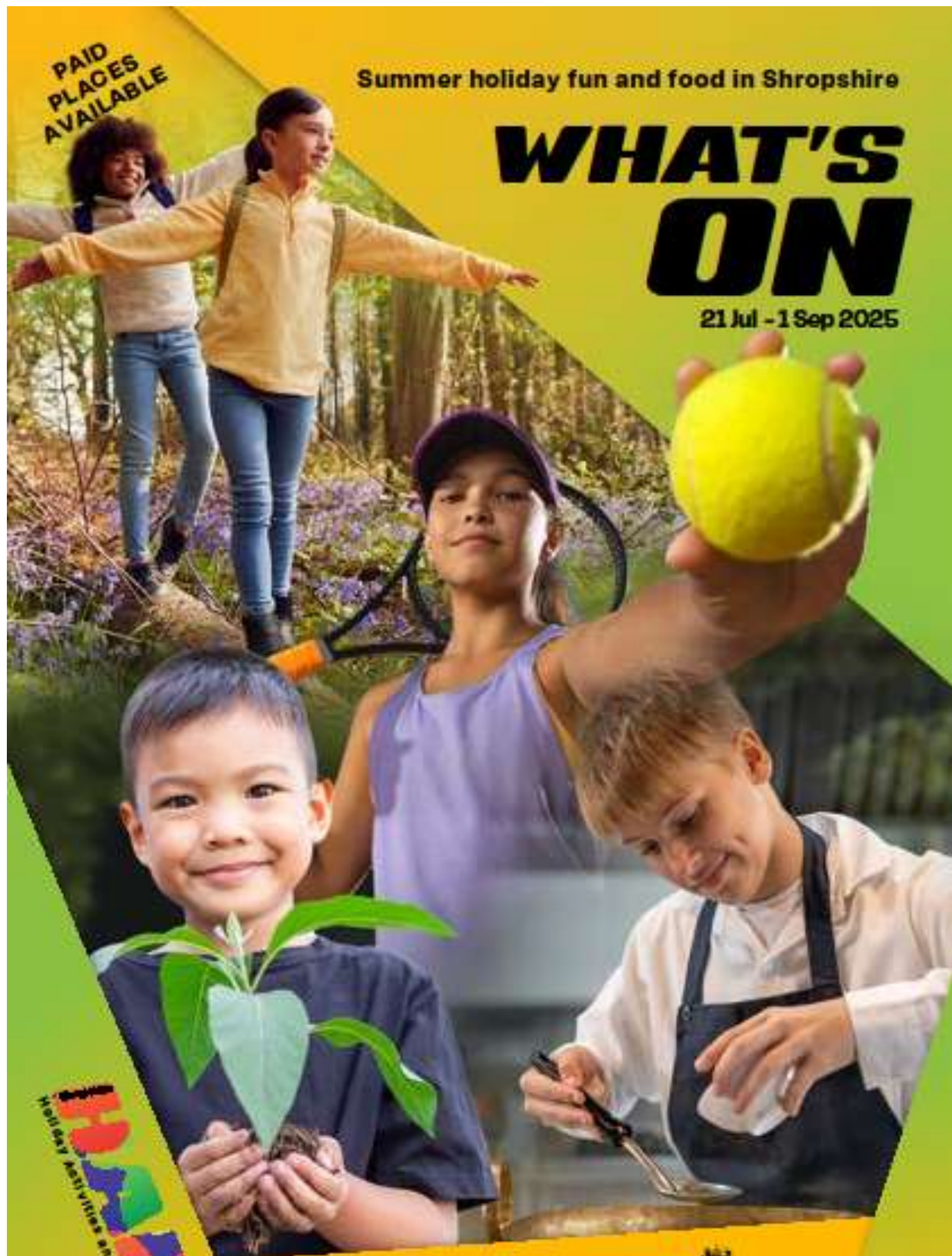

All bookings are being made directly with the organisations running the holiday clubs. Your child/ren will be given a HAF Information leaflet and unique code via their school. **You will need to use this code when booking.**

Codes

The unique code entitles your child/ren to attend 16 sessions of free holiday activity in Shropshire during the summer holidays.

Please don't use this code to book onto more than 16 sessions of activity, it won't be valid.

This code is individual to your child/s school and is not transferable to other children.

Eligibility checks are carried out on all bookings.

How do I know if my child/ren is able to access HAF activity for free?

Core Eligibility - There are free places available on the programme for children and young people aged 4 (who are in reception class or equivalent) to 16, who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals.

All eligible children and young people will get information about the programme direct from their school.

Professional Referrals

Wider Eligibility - There are a limited number of free places available for children and young people on the programme, living in areas of high deprivation (tiers 1 to 5 of deprivation, based on indices of deprivation/income) and/or from low-income households, who are not in receipt of benefits related free school meals.

These children and young people can be referred onto the programme by a professional.

Holiday clubs with places available for children and young people with SEND have been highlighted in the guide. These places are at holiday clubs offering mainstream activities with a range of children and young people.

Before booking onto any activity, please contact the provider to discuss your child's needs.

1:1 Support:

If your child/ren requires 1:1 support at school (mainstream or specialist) or in any other educational setting, they may also need 1:1 support to access the suitable HAF holiday clubs.

Currently, the HAF programme is unfortunately unable to fund 1:1 support - any child needing 1:1 support to access the programme would need to have 1:1 funding and support in place before attending.

If you have funding in place and need help sourcing a PA to support your child/ren to take part in HAF

activities, some of the activity providers can help. For a fee they may be able to provide a member of staff to offer your child/ren 1:1 support. Please ask the organisations direct about availability and costs. As mentioned above, HAF is not able to fund this 1:1 support.

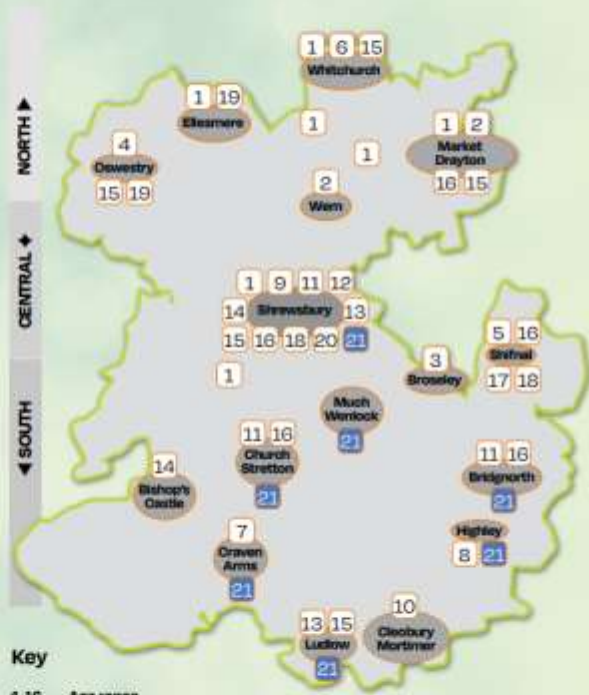

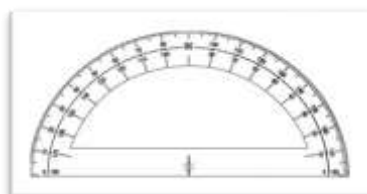
