MEDICATION FOR STUDENTS

Please remember if you are sending medication into school for a student, it must be accompanied by an 'Administration of Medicine' consent form. This form is available to download from our website under 'Letters and Downloadable Forms', or can be collected from the School Office.

All medication must be in the original container and have the student's name on the prescription label. Medication must be handed into Reception where it will be stored safely.

Students are not permitted to carry medication.

The only exceptions are inhalers and epipens, for which we hold consent forms.

HAF—Winter Holiday Fun and Food in Shropshire

We are excited to share details about the **Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme**, which offers **fun activities and healthy meals** for children and young people during the school holidays. **Free and Paid Places Available**

- Free places are available for children and young people who are in receipt of benefits-related Free School Meals (FSM) you will receive a unique booking code in a separate email if you are eligible.
- Paid places are also available for children and young people who are **not eligible for HAF**. These paid places are generally **heavily subsidised** and have been highlighted in the **What's On Guide** (sent via Parentmail).

SEND Opportunities - HAF providers are running holiday clubs with places available for **children and young people with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND).** These places are at settings offering **mainstream programmes** alongside a range of children and young people. These SEND-friendly opportunities have been highlighted in the **What's On Guide** (sent via Parentmail).

Important information before booking a place for a child with SEND:

Please contact providers directly before booking to discuss your child's needs and ensure the activity is suitable.

Currently, the HAF programme is **unable to fund 1:1 support**. Any child requiring 1:1 support must have this funding and support in place before attending. **How to book:**

- All bookings are made directly with the organisations running the clubs.
- Families eligible for HAF will need their **HAF code** when booking (sent via Parentmail). The What's On Guide also includes links to additional SEND resources and services. You can also view the guide and a searchable holiday club listing online:

<u>Parentpay</u>

When purchasing a book please refer to the price list included in the latest newsletter. Select the 'Revision Guides and Workbook' option.

In the notes field please enter the subject and whether it is a revision guide or workbook, and if the tier is Foundation or Higher. This will ensure the correct book is allocated to the student.

The price will always default to £10.50, please amend this to the correct amount from the latest price list within the Newsletter to ensure you are always paying the correct amount.

If you wish to buy more than one book a new transaction is required each time.
