The only exceptions are inhalers and epipens, for which we hold consent forms.

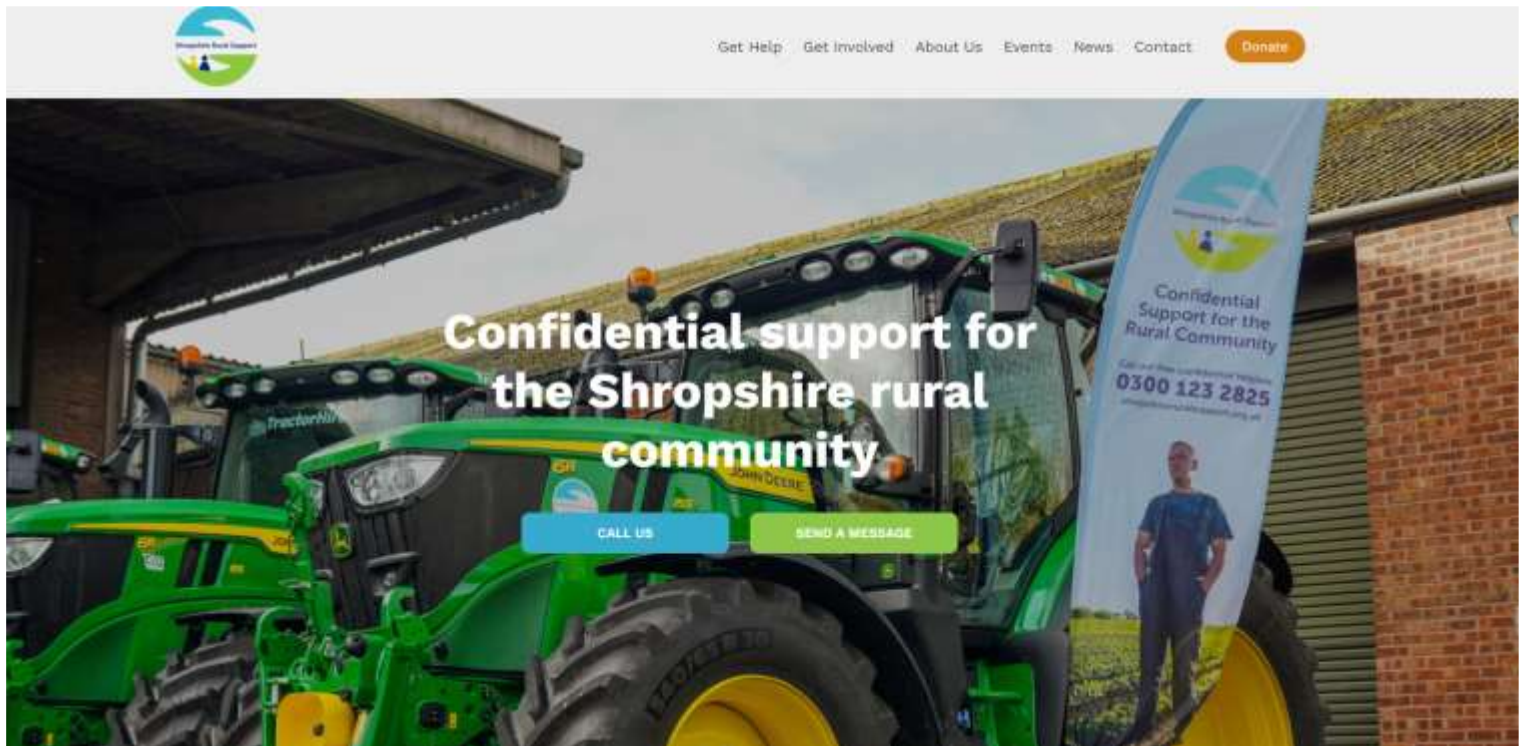

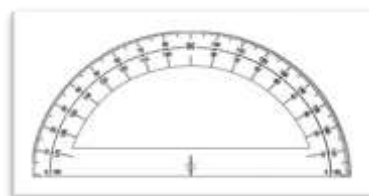

There are a variety of revision guides and workbooks which are available to purchase via Parentpay for collection by the student from student reception.

The selection of books and prices will be included each week in the newsletter, this will be updated to reflect any changes in price or guides available.

The list will also be available for students in their tutor groups and students can discuss any book requirements with their subject teacher.

Parentpay

When purchasing a book please refer to the price list included in the latest newsletter. Select the '**Revision** Guides and **Workbook**' option.

In the notes field please enter the subject and whether it is a revision guide or workbook, and if the tier is Foundation or Higher. This will ensure the correct book is allocated to the student.

The price will always default to £10.50, please amend this to the correct amount from the latest price list within the Newsletter to ensure you are always paying the correct amount.

If you wish to buy more than one book a new transaction is required each time.
